

Day 3 Leh To Nubra Valley via Khardung-La one of the highest motorable road

the home of 106 feet of Maitreya Buddha statue.

Further, we will pass over from Shyok River to reach Nubra Valley, also known as Ldorma or the Valley of Flowers.

If time permits, you can also take part in some adventure like a double-humped Bactrian camel safari or an ATV ride on the deserted land of Hunder Sand dunes.

We will then check into the hotel rooms and have a hearty dinner.

Here you can try out fruits like apricots and walnuts, for which this place is well known.


Next, you can take selfies and click pictures on the wooden bridge along the banks of the Shyok River.

Day 5 Nubra Valley To Pangong Tso | Explore colour-changing Lake

Wake up in the Nubra Valley and get ready for an adventurous journey to the famous Pangong Tso. While riding we will cross the charming Agam and Shyok villages which are known for their scenic beauty. Continue the adventurous journey until we are greeted with the majestic views of the famous Pangong Lake, also known as the "High Grassland Lake". Pangong Lake is about 4 km wide on average and at least 136 Km long and is located at an altitude of 4300 meters above sea level. Spend some time around the lake, where you can admire the reflection of the surrounding mountains in the stunning blue lake. You can also click pictures at the famous 3-idiots set here. We will then head to check in at our campsite near the lake and have a delicious dinner here.



Cancellation Policy

In order to cover our expected loss from the cancellation of the booking below is set scale of charges which must be paid by traveler.

20 % of total package cost will be charged as cancellation amount 30 or more days before your travel date.

40% of total package cost will be charged as cancellation amount between 20 to 30 days before your travel date.

60% of package cost will be charged as cancellation amount between 10 to 20 days before your travel date.

100% of package cost will be charged as cancellation amount less than 10 days before your travel date.

The Cancellation Policy is subject to change. It purely depends upon the cancellation policy of respective hotels. In Peak seasons, Some hotels may charge 100% cancellation. Refunds normally take 12 working days after the cancellation request has been raised & transferred electronically to your bank account

Points to Note

Climatic conditions in the high altitudes vary from the plains; it is advisable that you take adequate time to get acclimatized to high altitudes.

Consult a physician before undertaking the tour. Carry basic medications and a first-aid kit during the tour.

It is recommended to carry enough warm clothes and the right kind of shoes for the tour. The advisable baggage weight is 60 litres as you might have to carry the luggage to the backup vehicle, the accommodation, etc.

Rates may fluctuate with any change in services/hotels. The difference in the cost shall be borne by the client in case of any amendment in the package due to an increase in the number of guests, hotel change, etc., before the beginning of the trip.

The hotels are subject to their availability. In case they are not available, the travellers will be accommodated in a property of similar standard

Tripacation reserves the right to rearrange the itinerary due to any kind of disturbance that occurred (i.e

weather condition, political condition or any others) without changing the total number of days and without compromising any service.

Booking and Payment Conditions
