Day 1 Leh Arrival and Acclimatization

Arrive at the Leh airport after a scenic flight over the Himalayas. Meet our representative who will help you with your transfers to the hotel. Complete the check-in formalities and rest for some time. You can then spend the rest of the day at leisure.

We suggest you go for a short walk around your hotel, to acclimate yourself to the altitude better. Overnight stay in Leh.

Day 2 Leh Local Sightseeing, Overnight stay in Leh

Rise and shine! It's time to fuel up for an exciting day ahead with a delicious breakfast at the hotel. Get ready and board our transfers to explore the major landmarks towards Sham Valley.

Before heading out of Leh, we will first visit the iconic Shanti Stupa to marvel at the stunning views of Leh city.

Continue the adventurous ride to the Sham Valley, where we will first visit the Sangam point to witness the confluence of the Indus and Zanskar Rivers. the serene Pathar Sahib Gurudwara.

Next, we will stop at the Magnetic Hill to experience a unique optical illusion that looks like vehicles are rolling uphill.

Our last stop here will be the Pathar Sahib Gurudwara, dedicated to Guru Nanak Dev Ji.

Here, we will learn about the fascinating story behind the sacred boulder that has an imprint of Guru Nanak Ji.

We will then head back to Leh and visit the Hall of Fame, a museum/ war memorial built in memory of the martyrs of the Indo-Pak War that showcases various aspects of high-altitude warfare.

You can spend your evening exploring the vibrant local Leh market and indulging in some delicious food and drinks at the cozy cafes around.



Day 3

Leh To Nubra via Khardung-La [Distance: 125km, Duration: 5-6 Hrs]

Wake up in your hotel room in Leh and have a delicious breakfast.

We will then get you ready for the exciting journey on one of the highest motorable roads.

Rev Up your engines and get ready for a thrilling ride to the Nubra Valley located to the north of Ladakh between the Karakoram and Ladakh ranges of the Himalayas.

Our first stop will be the iconic Khardung-La - one of the highest motorable roads in the world at an altitude of 5359 meters.

Further, we will pass by the Shyok River to reach Nubra Valley, also known as Ldurma or the Valley of Flowers.

Continue riding through the mesmerizing landscapes until we reach Diskit.

Here, we will stop at the Diskit Monastery which is famous for its 106 feet of Maitreya Buddha statue. Upon reaching Nubra, head to the Hunder Sand Dunes where you can spend time soaking in the views of the cold desert.

You can also enjoy some adventure activities like a double-humped Bactrian camel ride or an ATV ride to explore the deserted land of Hunder. (on your own)

Complete your sightseeing for the day, and head to your camps/ hotels.

Overnight stay in Nubra Valley.




Day 4

Nubra to Turtuk Day Excursion [Distance: 200km, Duration 7H]


Wake up to a beautiful sunrise, and post breakfast depart for Turtuk, a remote village of about 4,000 residents inhabited by ethnic Muslims. Steeped in history, culture, and traditions, Turtuk offers a fascinating glimpse into the lives of its hospitable locals who will welcome you with open arms. Spend some time in the pristine landscapes of Turtuk Village & Come back to Hunder by evening. Treat your taste buds to a delectable dinner and settle in for a cozy night's sleep that will leave you feeling refreshed and energized.

Day 5 Transfer from Nubra to Pangong [Distance: 160 Km, Duration: 5-6 Hours]

Wake up in the Nubra Valley and get ready for an adventurous journey to the famous Pangong Tso. While riding, we will cross the charming Agam and Shyok villages which are known for their scenic beauty.

Continue the adventurous journey until we are greeted with the majestic views of the famous Pangong Lake which is the highest saltwater lake in the world.

Pangong Lake is about 4 km wide on average and at least 136 Km long and is located at an altitude of 4300 meters above sea level.

Spend some time around the lake, where you can admire the reflection of the surrounding mountains in the stunning blue lake.

You can also click pictures at the famous 3-idiots set here.

We will then head to check in at our campsite near the lake and have a delicious dinner here.

Overnight stay near Pangong Lake.

Day 6 Leh to Hanle via Tsagala Pass [Distance 165: km, Duration 8 to 9hrs]

Your journey begins early in the morning from Leh as you set out on an exhilarating drive towards the remote and serene village of Hanle. After a light breakfast provided by our team, you'll travel along the Leh-Manali highway towards Karu and Upshi, gradually leaving behind the urban bustle. The route follows the meandering Indus River, leading you to the steaming hot springs of Chumathang—a perfect spot to pause and soak in the therapeutic beauty of Ladakh. Continuing through Mahe and the military-controlled zones of Nyoma and Loma, you'll finally reach Hanle by late afternoon or early evening. One of the most secluded settlements in India, Hanle is known for its vast skies, peaceful silence, and the majestic Hanle Monastery perched above the valley. Upon arrival, you'll be welcomed at a local guesthouse or homestay where dinner awaits, lovingly prepared by locals and arranged by our team.

Day 7 Hanle to Tsomoriri [Distance: 150km, Duration: 4-5 Hrs]

Today we shall move to beautiful Tso Moriri Lake via Nyoma and Mahe bridge. Situated at an altitude of 4,522 meters, the lake is 19km long, 3km wide and has maximum depth of 105m. The lake is a Ramsar wetland, a home to dozens of species of migratory birds. Visit Korzok monastery on top of

village and have walk along the bank of the lake. The lake gets freeze in the winter months. The residents walk over the frozen lake along with their cattle in winters. Walk along the lakeside in the evening time. Don't miss the mesmerizing view of sunset and sunrise. Tso Moriri is a perfect place for stargazing. Overnight in Swiss camps/guest house at Korzok village.

Day 8 Tsomoriri to Leh Via Puga & Tsokar [Distance: 220km, Duration: 7 hrs]

After breakfast retrace the route down to Puga Sumdo and then follow the road across the Polokongka Pass (4920 mtrs) to visit Tsokar Lake, a salt lake system in the Rupsho plateau which is home of the Changpa nomads and support many rare wild life species. After sightseeing of the area take the Manali-Leh road to return to Leh, crossing Taglang-la (alt: 17,585ft) en- route. Visit Thiksey Monastery and Rancho school if time allows. Arrive at hotel in Leh for dinner and overnight.

Cancellation Policy

In order to cover our expected loss from the cancellation of the booking below is set scale of charges which must be paid by traveler.

20 % of the total package cost will be charged as a cancellation amount 30 or more days before your travel date.

40% of the total package cost will be charged as a cancellation amount between 20 to 30 days before your travel date.

60% of the package cost will be charged as a cancellation amount between 10 to 20 days before your travel date.

100% of the package cost will be charged as a cancellation amount less than 10 days before your travel date.

The Cancellation Policy is subject to change. It purely depends upon the cancellation policy of respective hotels. In Peak seasons, Some hotels may charge 100% cancellation. Refunds normally take 12 working days after the cancellation request has been raised & transferred electronically to your bank account

Points to Note

Climatic conditions in the high altitudes vary from the plains; you should take adequate time to get acclimatized to high altitudes.

Consult a physician before undertaking the tour. Carry basic medications and a First-aid kit during the tour.

Rates may fluctuate with any change in services/hotels. The difference in the cost shall be borne by the client in case of any amendment in the package due to an increase in the number of guests, hotel change, etc., before the beginning of the trip.

The hotels are subject to their availability. In case they are not available, the travellers will be

accommodated in a property of similar standard.

Tripacation reserves the right to rearrange the itinerary due to any kind of disturbance that occurs (i.e. weather conditions, political conditions or any others) without changing the total number of days and without compromising any service.

Booking and payment conditions
